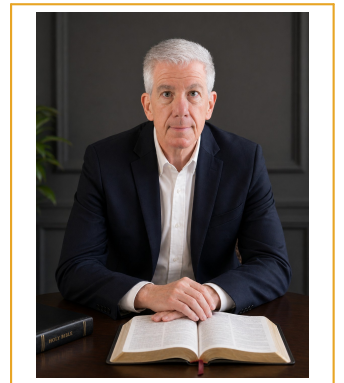
Building a Faith-Rooted Adult Day Health Care Solution for Arizona Seniors

I founded Lending Hands Outreach with a simple conviction: vulnerable seniors should not be left without practical support when families need help and local provider capacity is limited.

LHO is currently completing ADHS Adult Day Health Care Facility pre-licensure preparation while building the funding, facility, referral, and community partnerships required for launch. Our initial focus is West Phoenix and nearby underserved West Valley communities.

My professional background includes systems development, engineering, digital media, eCommerce operations, and organizational planning. I am applying that experience to LHO's compliance systems, financial model, partnerships, and proposed care-delivery operations.

Arizona faces a documented shortage of Adult Day Health Care capacity. LHO is being developed to help address that shortage through a safe, accountable model that may include supervised daytime care, health monitoring, meals, transportation support, and person-centered programming for eligible seniors.

Guided by Matthew 25, we believe faith should be demonstrated through practical service, responsible stewardship, and respect for every person. LHO intends to serve eligible members without discrimination, and participation in spiritual activities will always be optional.

Current Development Priorities

- Complete ADHS pre-licensure preparation and facility-readiness planning
- Secure an accessible West Valley facility appropriate for the proposed program
- Build the operating reserve required for a responsible launch
- Finalize staffing, transportation, meal-service, compliance, and referral systems

Partnership Opportunities

- Launch funding and introductions to qualified grantmakers
- Potential facility leads and in-kind equipment support
- Relationships with senior-serving agencies, churches, caregivers, and community organizations
- Professional expertise in licensing, facilities, transportation, and nonprofit operations
